

DETAILED EQUIPMENT CHECKLIST:

- ___ 1-2 duffle bags, (2 long narrow bags preferred versus 1 big, bulky bag)
- ___ 2 light wool or polar fleece shirts
- ___ 1 heavy wool or polar fleece shirt
- ___ 2 changes of poly propylene underwear or equivalent
- ___ 2 pairs of pants of which wool or fleece is recommended
- ___ 4 pairs of jockey shorts or equivalent
- ___ 4-5 pairs of socks of which wool is recommended
- ___ 2 bandanas
- ___ 1 wool cap or equivalent
- ___ 1 felt hat or hunting cap
- ___ 2 pairs of light gloves and 2 pairs insulated gloves
- ___ 1 insulated jacket (down or equivalent)
- ___ 1 wool or fleece jacket
- ___ 1 pair of broken in hiking boots
- ___ 1 pair of heavy soled, 'well broken in' hiking boots suitable for climbing
- ___ 1 pair of snow pack boots (i.e. lined) for hunts from Oct. 1st on
- ___ 1 pair of camp shoes
- ___ 1 sleeping bag rated for late fall/early winter (can be arranged for European clients)
- ___ 1 toilet kit
- ___ 1 full set of rain gear (gore-tex or equivalent)
- ___ 1 hunting knife
- ___ 1 day pack (larger packs are required for sheep and goat hunts)
- ___ 1 pair of binoculars "8X40" or larger recommended
- ___ 1 spotting scope and tripod, not mandatory but recommended
- ___ 1 camera with spare batteries and extra film or memory cards for digital cameras
- ___ 2 boxes of ammunition
- ___ 2 small flashlights or headlamps with lots of spare batteries
- ___ 1 .270 calibre rifle or better- 30 calibre magnums are recommended
- ___ 2 riflescope covers
- ___ 1 pair sunglasses
